AOH SEAN MACBRIDE DIVISION #32 SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

1. Nominees may qualify for the AOH Sean MacBride Division #32 scholarship under the following membership conditions:

A. The nominee may be a <u>member</u> of the Division. The member must be active and in good standing. An active member is one who regularly attends meetings and functions. (A photocopy of the current year membership card must be submitted.)

B. A nominee may be a <u>son or daughter/grandson or granddaughter</u> of an active member, in good standing, who has been a member of the Order for at least <u>3 years</u>. An active member is one who regularly attends meetings and functions. (A photocopy of the current year membership card must be submitted.)

C. A nominee may also be a son or daughter/grandson or granddaughter of a <u>deceased</u> Division #32 member, who was a member in good standing. The deceased member must have been one that regularly attended meetings and functions. (A photocopy of the latest membership card, or a document attesting to the above, signed by their Division President, must be submitted.)

- 2. One award will be given out for a total of \$1,000.00. If no nominees meet the standards requested by this committee, standards will not be lowered to find a winner. Therefore, it is possible to not award any scholarships in a given year.
- 3. Minimum standards for awardees are that they must be accepted for enrollment at an accredited college, trade/vocational school, and must be a practicing Catholic in good standing with the church.
- 4. Other factors to be considered by the scholarship committee include, but are not limited to:
 - a. Active as a volunteer in his or her community.
 - b. Active in extracurricular activities including, but not limited to, after-school employment.
 - c. Academic credentials.
 - d. Letters of recommendation.
 - e. Financial need.
- 5. Those wishing to be considered for the award must have completed an <u>Entry Form</u> by his or her school district guidance department, or the equivalent, if applicable. Forms must be received by the committee chairman by <u>Saturday, March 27, 2021</u> for consideration. An <u>Application Form</u> must be completed by the nominee and also returned by <u>Saturday, March 27, 2021</u>.
- 6. A letter from a parish priest of his or her parish stating his support for the candidate as a member in good standing and listing the candidates' activities within the parish, if applicable. As with the other applicable forms, this letter is due on or before **Saturday, March 27, 2021**.
- 7. A letter from the candidate must be submitted explaining how and where they will further his or her education. Scholarship awards will be distributed to the student, rather than the school, in order to ensure maximum benefit to the student.
