

## AOH Division 32 Hibernian of the Year & Service Awards – 2023

To assure that every dues-paying brother of Division 32 has the opportunity to vote for Hibernian of the Year and the Service Awards, your ballot is included. You **MUST** be paid-up in your dues for your ballot to be valid.

It can be handed to John Truel, at the Division 32 meeting on Sunday, February 12<sup>th</sup>, or postal mailed to him at 136 Cedar Blvd., Pittsburgh, PA 15228 for arrival no later than Monday March 27, 2023 deadline. Ballots will be tabulated promptly after the deadline.

Once all the ballots are in, a committee of the five recent Hibernians of the Year, to be determined by the current Division 32 president, will meet to tabulate the ballots and break ties by secret ballot where necessary. That committee will be chaired in 2023 by Paul Towhey Jr, who was the 2022 winner, and will consist of John Truel, Bill Delaney, Denny Donnelly, and Bernie Donnelly. (The 2023 Hibernian of the Year will take in the 2023 ballots and chair next year's committee, thus rotating the responsibility.)

Occasionally a non-member may be voted a special award, as when George Bado was named an Honorary Hibernian in 2003 and David Calabria was voted a special award in 2013.

It is possible to win Division 32's Hibernian of the Year Award and the Service Award more than once. All winners must be active members of the division. Efforts should be made by the committee to recognize all eligible individuals.

Ballots will be distributed approximately one month prior to the annual Communion breakfast, which in 2023 falls on April 16<sup>th</sup>, and must be submitted by March 27, 2023. The breakfast is always the 1<sup>st</sup> Sunday after Easter.

Hibernians of the Year:

Note: Although AOH Division 32 was established Sept. 17, 1989, this award was not given until 1993. LAOH 32 was established May 19, 1991.

Until 2003 there was no fixed pattern of one man and one woman being selected each year. Sometimes it was one man, sometimes one woman. In 1995 the award was given to the Joyce sisters. Because women exclusively sometimes won the award, all women winners are included in the roster below in the interest of completeness.
